Melanie was going to see if she could provide Mary with a copy of the engineering report they have done so far.

• South Crawford Rd Pavement

Rolfe suggested that we should educate the membership on what is truly wrong with the paved portion of Crawford Rd. Pictures will be obtained and presented at the annual meeting to show the unraveling and deterioration that will soon lead to needing to replace rather than be able to repair that portion of the road.

New Business:

• Maintenance

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Mary made the motion to all MCRA to spend \$1500 to repair, grade and add more material to the area of Crawford just South of Venturi Way. Mitch Morley would be doing the repairs. Tara seconded the motion, all board members approved. Motion passes.
